TCA DESCRIPTION

Themes and goals: Languages are very important in citizens' life: they are a key to communication

and social inclusion. They are very closely linked to the development of intercultural competences, critical thinking, social and civic engagement. They enhance cross-border mobility and cooperation and thus raise awareness on and understanding of the common European values.
