learning process and strategic partnerships under Erasmus+.

The thematic focus will be how to better promote the European values and democratic participation in day-by-day activity, considering Erasmus+ as a tool to empower all the beneficiaries in this sense. Thus, this TC is addressing all sectors in Erasmus+ eligible for strategic partnerships: education, training and youth and it will gather representatives from NGOs, youth associations, schools, VET organizations, universities, public institutions and public authorities, companies.
